The target audience includes health care personnel, as well as community partners from Public Health, laboratory and EMS. Regional preparedness efforts at the local, state and national level will be discussed.

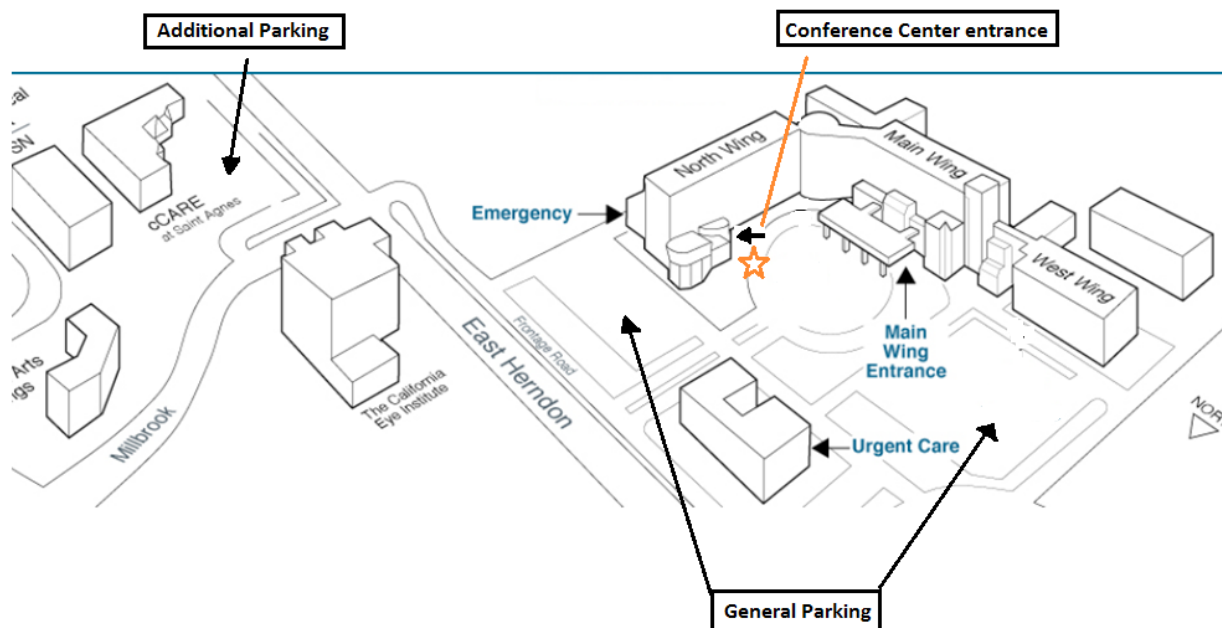
