The primary goals of the National APIC Conference Award are to:

- Provide awards to San Diego and Imperial APIC Chapter members who are seeking to enhance their skills and abilities in the infection control profession; and
- Demonstrate APIC's commitment to promoting infection prevention competency and certification

Overview

APIC is the leading professional association for infection preventionists (IPs) with more than 15,000 members. Our mission is to create a safer world through the prevention of infection. This is achieved by the provision of better care to promote better health at a lower cost. [APIC Strategic Plan 2020](#) outlines five key areas in which APIC can make significant contributions: patient safety; implementation science; infection preventionist competencies and certification; advocacy; and data standardization.

Application Requirements

The award will provide a total of \$2,000 for registration, lodging, and other event related expenses for the APIC National Conference June 10-12th.

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be a current chapter member and maintain APIC membership throughout the grant period; if you are not yet a member but would like to submit an application for this award, please go here <https://apic.org/Member-Services/Join> to join as a member.
- Applicant **has** attended at least 3 chapter meetings or chapter events within the last 12-months, or has been qualitatively accountable for contributions to the profession

- Applicants must complete a self-assessment of individual knowledge and skills based on the APIC Competency Model and determine their professional stage (Advanced/Expert, Mid-Career, or Early Career) using the “Examples to Assist with Self-Definition of IP Career Stage” (*attachment in link below*).
- Applicant is to write a brief description of three things s/he has accomplished at the current career stage.
- Applicant is to write a brief description of three things s/he has accomplished at the current career stage.
- The awarded applicant will be required to present a 15-minute presentation about information learned at the National APIC Conference. This requirement must be met in order to meet National APIC non-profit qualifications for educational support. Presentations must be submitted to the SD/IC APIC Board (send to sdicapic@gmail.com) one week prior to the meeting when the recipient will present.

Selection Criteria

1. Current San Diego and Imperial APIC Chapter member
2. Chapter meeting or event attendance or participation; or professional contributions
3. Completed and submitted application before due date
4. Preferred Board Certified in Infection Prevention and Control
5. Preferred returning applicants who have been previously denied the award, who meets application eligibility
