This quarter has been an extremely busy one as the committee has continued to advance both its ongoing/recurring work, as well as a number of new membership and chapter projects. The committee had an in-person meeting at APIC Headquarters in May. The weather was beautiful, and it was the perfect

setting for forward-thinking discussion and work on several initiatives including:



- **Member Groups:** APIC's new member groups will provide practice and/or interest specific engagement and networking, as well as opportunities for members to further contribute to APIC and the field. The new member group structure is set to launch this summer.
- Mentoring: Mentoring is a critical component of APIC's strategic priorities. New mentoring programs are being launched at both the national and chapter levels. The chapter mentoring program will offer participating chapters tools and resources to facilitate local mentoring programs at several levels depending on the needs and capacity of the chapter. - Chapter Speaker Database: The MSC has developed a dynamic expert/speaker listing for local chapters. The <u>recommendation form</u> was shared in the June CLN and will be used to capture and later share local speaker recommendations as a resource for chapters planning educational meetings or conferences.

The MSC and APIC staff have worked to create an engaging program that facilitates networking, learning, and brainstorming that will help develop new skills and inspire ideas and action to take your chapter to the next level.
