# Federal Issues



- Rep. Mike Johnson (R-LA) has been elected new Speaker of the House after weeks of deliberation
- This comes after ousting Rep. Kevin McCarthy from his position as Speaker after his historic 15 rounds of voting in January 2023
- Rep. Jim Jordan, Rep. Steve Scalise, and Rep. Thomas Emmer were among some of the few that were discussed as options. Scalise and Emmer withdrew, and Jordan went through 3 rounds of voting before withdrawing his name from the ballot
- The current CR is in place until November 17th, congress must pass appropriations or face another risk of a shutdown.
- One of the youngest members to ever be elected as Speaker, only joining the house in 2016.



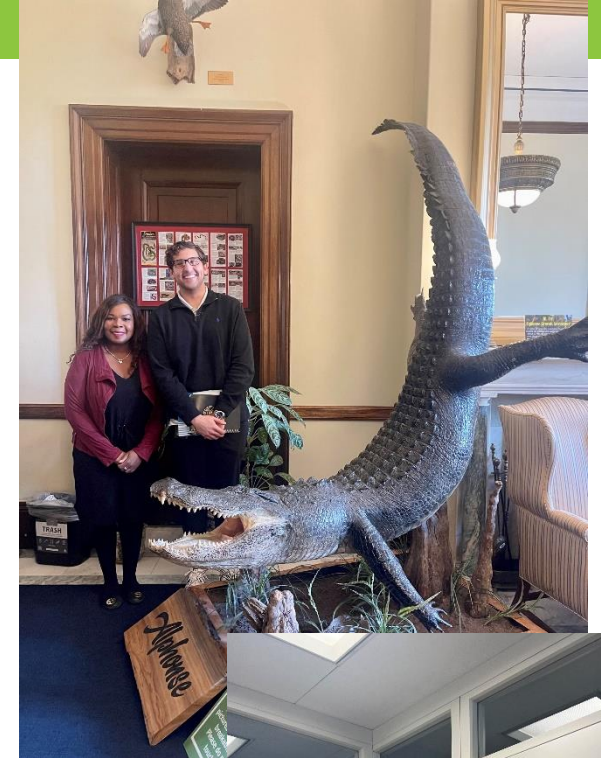
## Appropriations Challenges

- So we avoided a shutdown (for now)...what's next?
  - Continued Resolution will lapse November 17<sup>th</sup>, spending bill must be passed by then
  - House and Senate remain at odds
  - First bill was passed in the house 210-199, contains cuts \$5billion in spending from climate, tax, and health care, WH has threatened veto
  - Senate has agreed on three-bill spending “minibus”





- On October 10<sup>th</sup>, the BOD flew into Washington to participate in Hill Days.
- Threat of shutdown
- Nursing standards
- 42 meetings in all, hybrid style

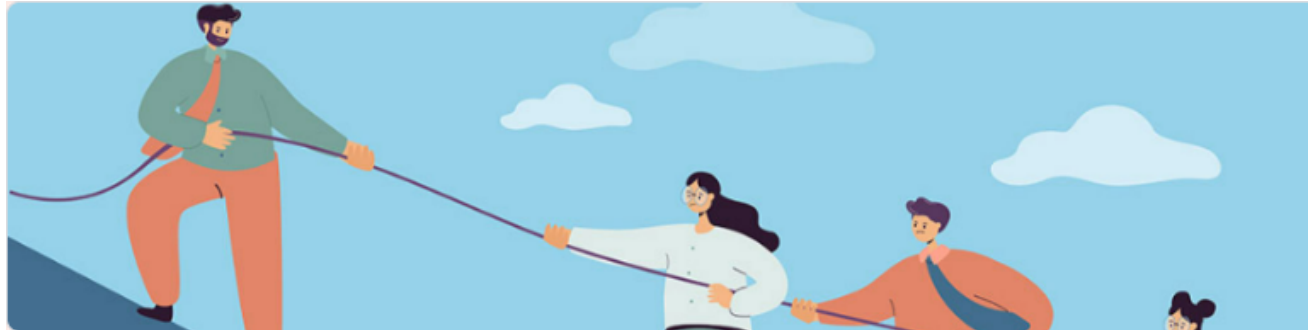

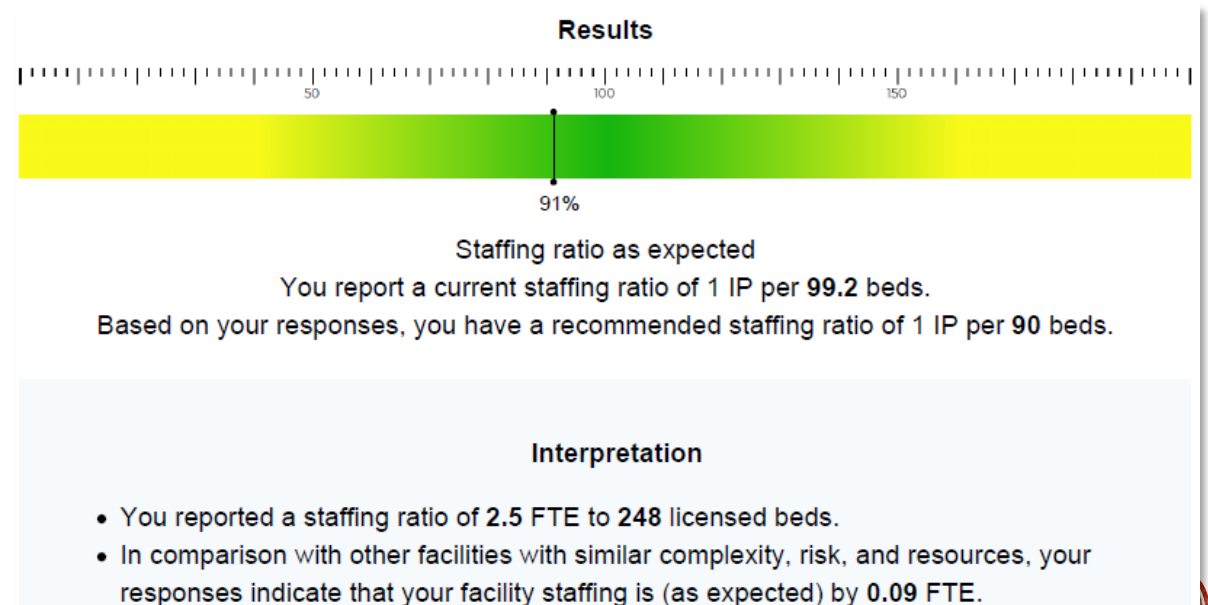

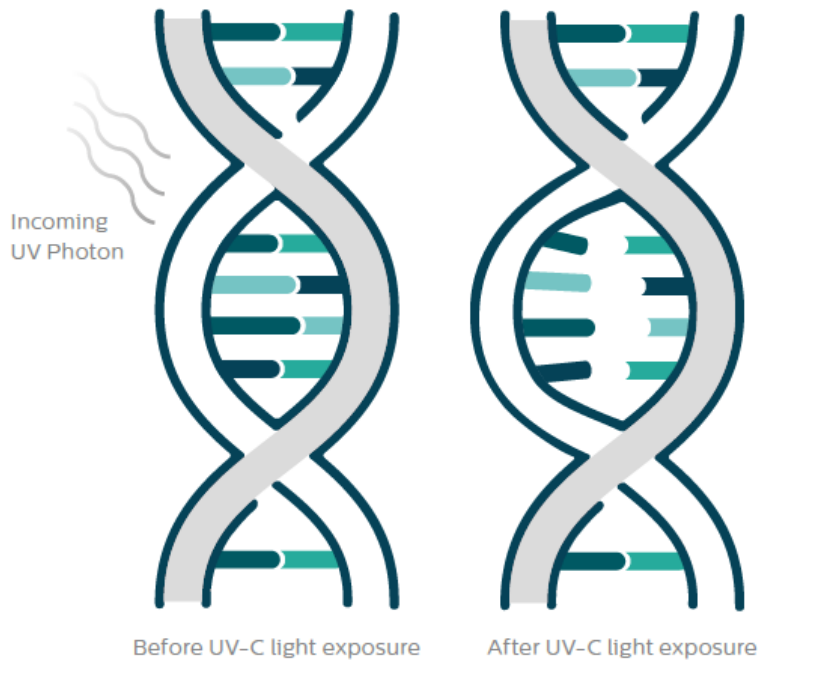

# Overview of UVC

## How it Works

**UVC works using a photolytic effect** whereby the radiation passes through the cell walls and damages the DNA of the micro-organism so that it can no longer multiply and therefore, **completely destroys it.**



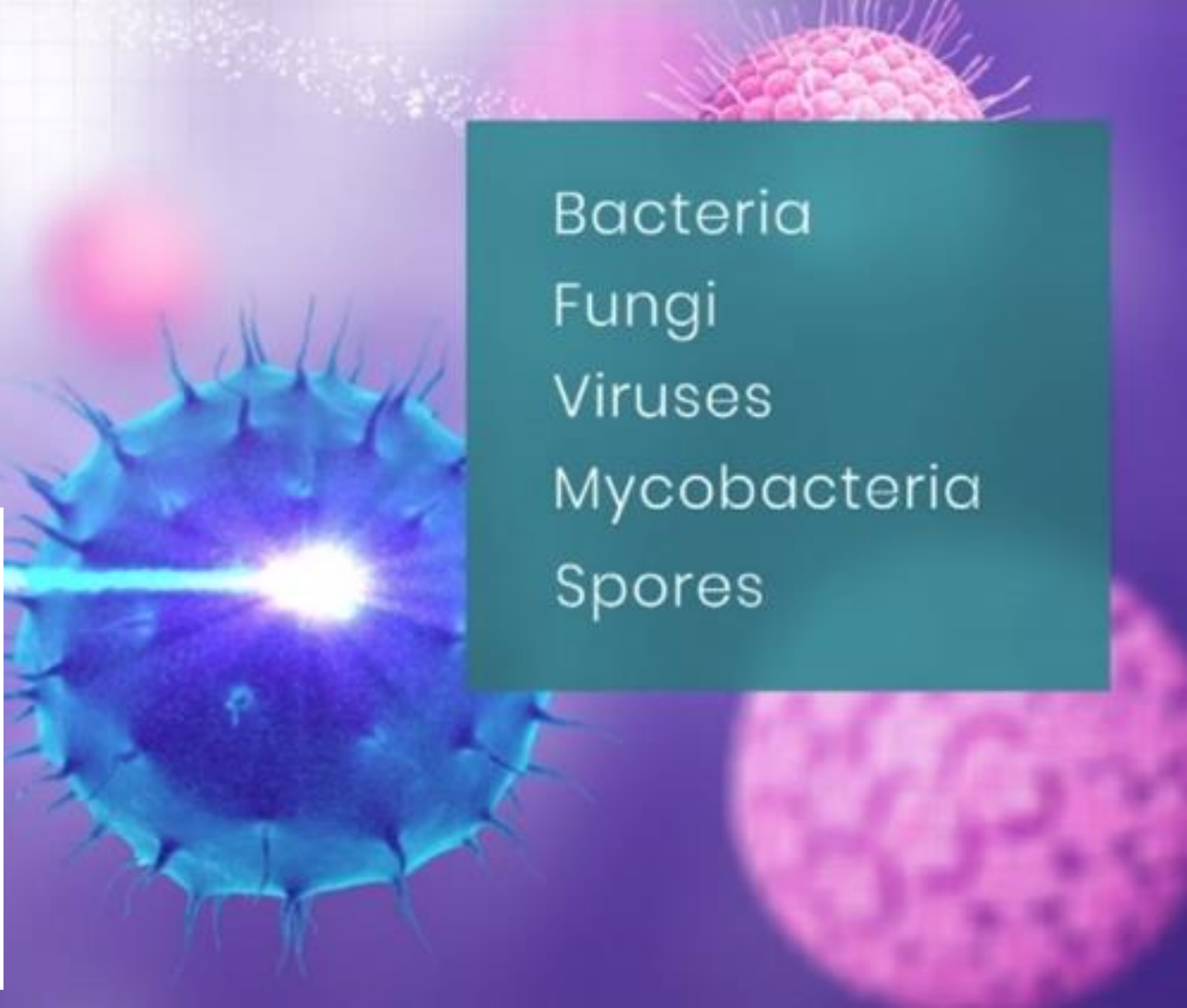

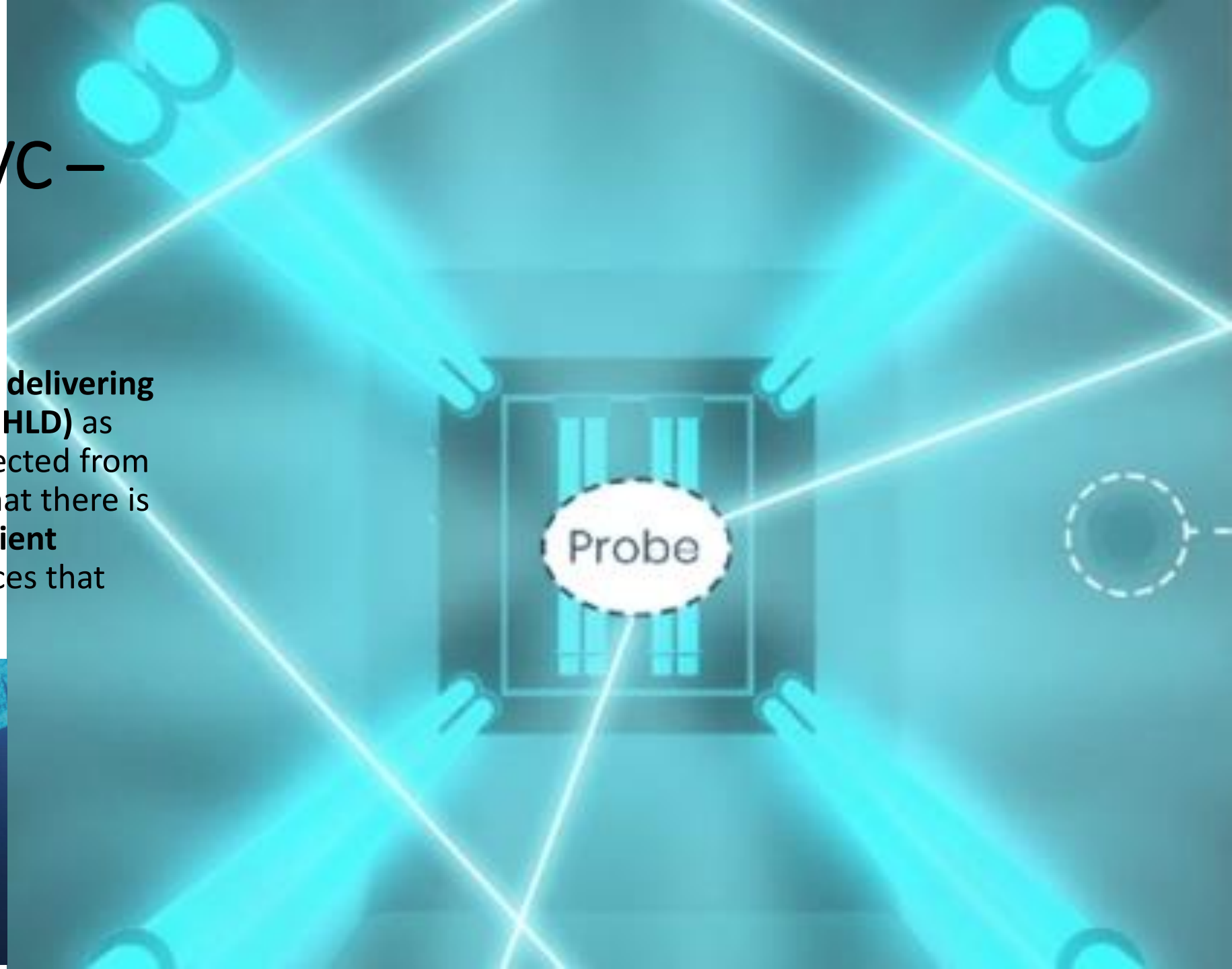
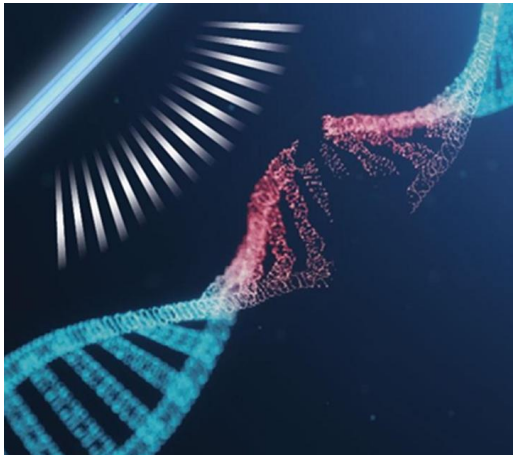

# Overview of UVC – How it Works

Unique technology works by delivering **UV-C high level disinfection (HLD)** as light particles and waves reflected from the chamber walls ensures that there is proper **illumination and efficient exposure** on the probe surfaces that **removes surface shadowing**.
